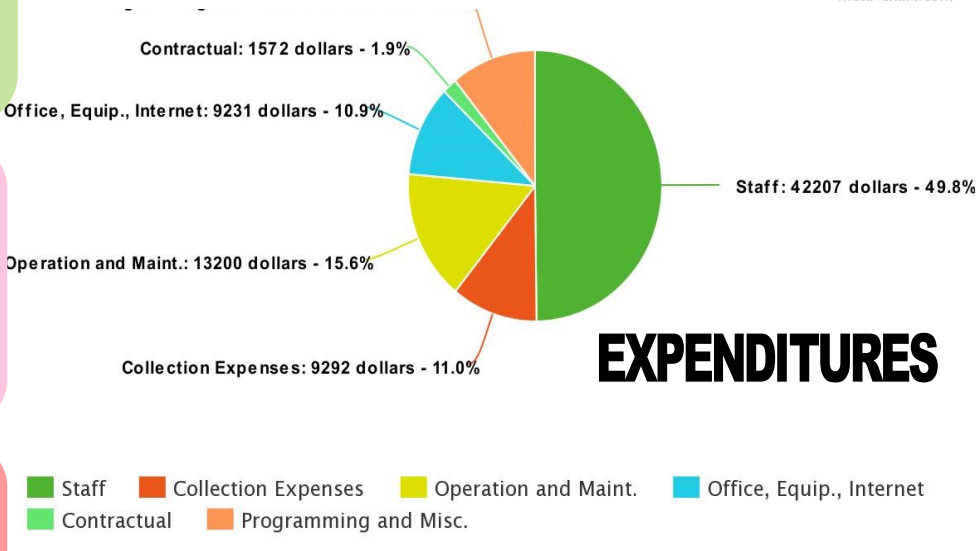
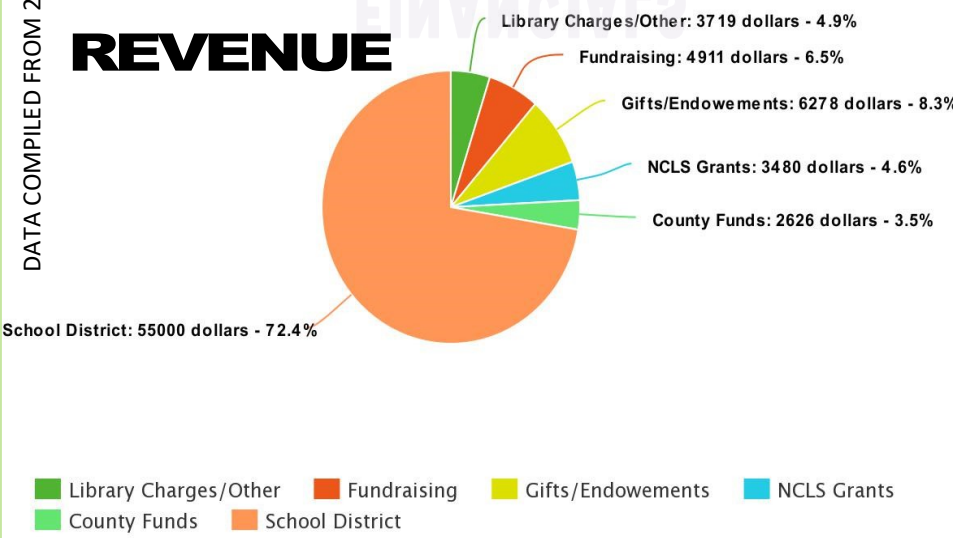

IN 2018...

- ◆ Went live with our Fiber Optics Internet bringing the library up to 100 MBPS per FCC requirements...Funding for equipment and installation came from E-rate which assists public libraries and schools with affordable telecommunications, Internet access and internal connections.
- ◆ Changed from landline phone service to VOIP internet service with many extra features and less monthly expense...
- ◆ We offered a free lunch program in coordination with the Food Bank of Central New York Summer Food Service Program to all children 18 and under and coordinated with the recreation program at the playground and brought meals to the children there too!
- ◆ Hired two summer Interns for the Summer Reading Program through a grant from Pratt-Northam Foundation.
- ◆ Hired a permanent Library Aide for 24 hours per week in order to offer more services!
